WANDSWORTH BOROUGH COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(2)

SUSPENSION OF BUS LANES – QUEENSTOWN ROAD AND CHELSEA BRIDGE

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Wandsworth intends to introduce a temporary bus lane suspension to allow installation of armadillos and wands in a cycle lane (hereinafter referred to as "the works").
- 2. The road suspensions will be in effect on Thursday 13 January 2022 between the hours of 1.00am and 7.00am and will remain in force during the said hours for the duration of the works, subject to a maximum period of 5 days. The works are anticipated to be completed within 1 day.
- 3. Whilst the works take place, the following lengths of bus lane will be suspended, the effect being that vehicular traffic will be permitted to proceed in that length of bus lane:-
 - (a) Queenstown Road, between its junctions with Carriage Drive North and Chelsea Bridge;
 - (b) Chelsea Bridge, between its junction with Queenstown Road and the borough boundary with the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.
- 4. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986
