In accordance with information provided at "*Section 1 – Advertisement and consultation*" of the application form I sent letters (based on Annex C1 in the PINS guidance) to:

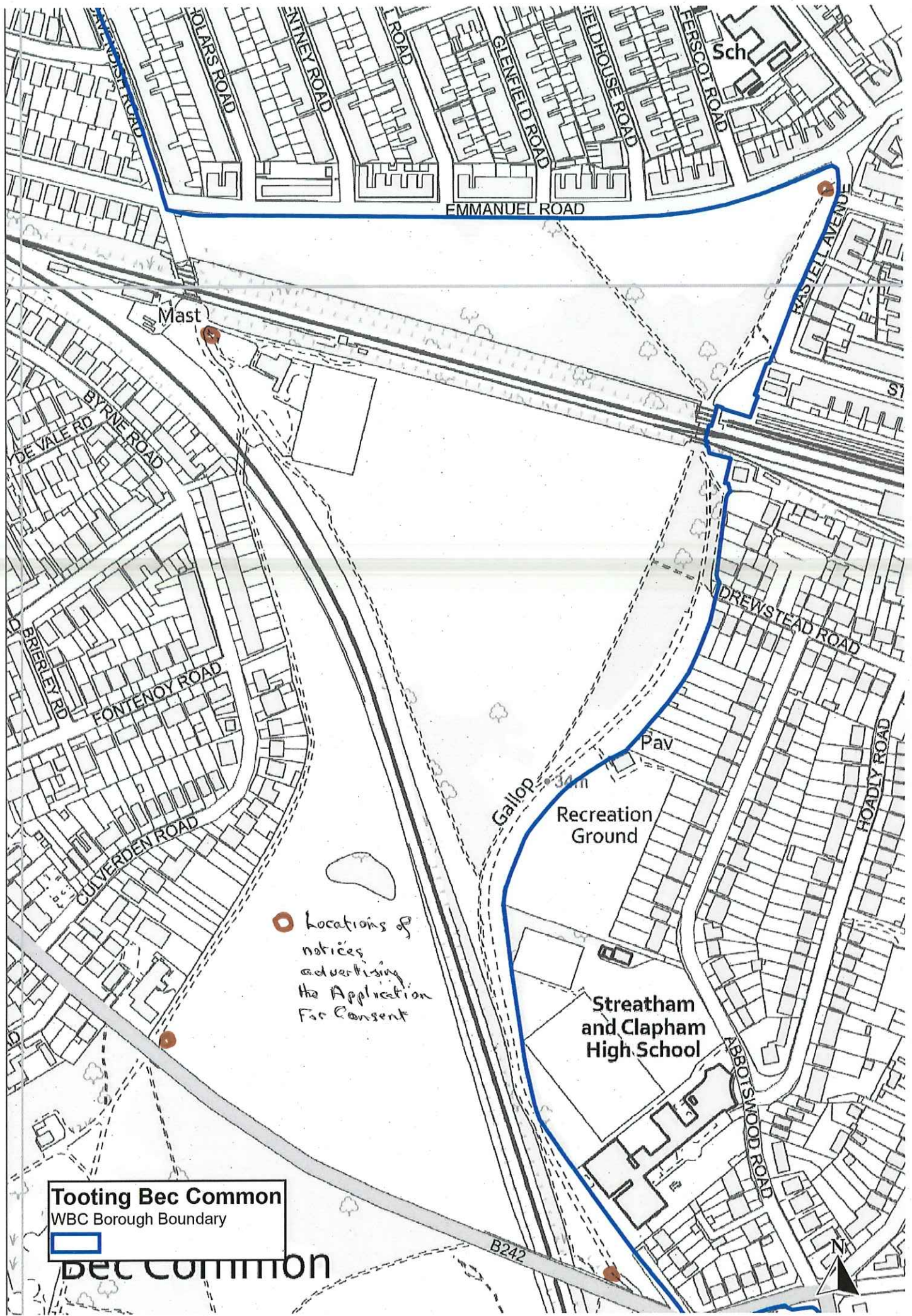
