# YORK GARDENS - A SUMMARY OF THE PLAY PROPOSALS

With the commencement of ground works for the build of Block 5 in the northern section of York Gardens underway, Wandsworth Borough Council made the decision to close the playground located there for safety reasons.

The play provision will not be lost however, plans have been made by the Joint Venture for a new playground in the southern section of the park as well as playable elements along the park edge, as shown.

These improvements will cater for all ages and provide a diversity of play experiences and development of skills, offering play for children of all abilities.

Outside of the main Woodland Play Area, there will be fitness equipment and relocated table tennis tables offering play and exercise opportunities for older children.

The new playground and improvements to York Gardens will commence in February 2022, with the playground due to open in May 2022.
