

EU Services Directive Information for Industrial Installations

Standard attachments paragraphs

Part B Application

1. A suitable map showing the location of the installation clearly defining extent of the installations in red
2. A suitable plan showing the layout of activities on the site, including bulk storage of materials, waste storage areas and any external emission points to atmosphere
3. Describe the proposed installation and activities and identify the foreseeable emissions to air from each stage of the process (this will include any foreseeable emissions during start up, shut down and any breakdown/abnormal operation)
The use of process flow diagrams may aid to simplify the operations
4. A document characterising each emission (including odour) and quantifying them (further specific details given in section B2.2 of the application form).
5. For each emission identified from the installations" activities describe the current and proposed technology and other techniques for preventing or, where that is not practicable, reducing the emissions into the air. If no techniques are used this should be stated.
6. Describe the proposed systems to be used in the event of unintentional releases and their consequences. This must identify, assess and minimise the environmental risks and hazards, provide a risk based assessment of any likely unintentional releases, including the use of historical evidence. If no assessments have been carried out please state.
7. Describe the proposed measures for monitoring all identified emissions including any environmental monitoring, and the frequency, measurement methodology and evaluation procedure proposed (e.g. particulate matter emissions, odour etc). Include the details of any monitoring which has been carried out which has not been requested in any other part of this application. If no monitoring is proposed for an emission please state the reason.
8. Provide detailed procedures and policies of your proposed environmental management techniques, in relation to the installation activities described.
9. Provide an assessment of the potential significant local environmental effects of the foreseeable emissions (e.g. is there a history of complaints and/or is the installation in an air quality management area ?)
10. Provide an assessment of whether the installation is likely to have a significant effect on sites of special scientific interest (SSSIs) or European protected sites and, if it is, provide an assessment of the implications of the installation for that site, for the purposes of the Conservation (Natural Habitats etc) Regulations 1994 (see appendix 2 of Annex XVIII of the General Guidance Manual).

11. Please supply a copy of the environmental impact assessment and details of any decision made, if one has been carried out under The Town and Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment)(England & Wales) Regulations 1999/293, or for any other reason with respect to the installation.
12. Please supply any additional information which you would like us to take account of in considering this application.
