Meeting Summary

Minutes

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 26 June 2018 were agreed.

Programme Progress Report

Ms Johnson summarised the circulated development programme which was subsequently discussed by the Steering Group.

Planning Application Update

Ms Johnson outlined the key dates leading to the submission of the planning application, including workshops scheduled with the Design Review Panel in August and subsequent design freeze. Mr Parrett summarised the amendments that had been made to the design of Block O, following comments from the DRP. The Steering Group noted that feedback from the public consultations will be analysed and fully reflected as part of the planning application, and additional information will be presented at the exhibition on 1 September to address some of the comments received, with a newsletter to follow.

Bessborough Road and Fontley Way Satellite Sites

Mr Boxall outlined the programme of work that must be accomplished before building can start on site at Bessborough Road in early 2019. The Steering Group was introduced to Jennifer Offord who will be responsible for the day-to-day project management on Fontley Way and the design code on the main application for Redrow Homes.

Community Facilities Update

The Steering Group noted that a committee paper is being finalised on the proposed changes to youth services in the area. It was noted that the landscape architects are working up more detailed plans for the proposed improvements to the facilities at the Alton Activity Centre. Mr Boxall informed the Steering Group that discussions involving the architects were being arranged with the GP surgeries.

Consultation and Community Engagement

The Steering Group noted the plans for the Get Active Roehampton Festival which will take place on 1 September, offering sports activities, health and wellbeing stands, and stage performances.
