Furzedown	67	76%	road safety, air quality, adjust timings, concern about visitors,	15%	inconvenience to residents, traffic displacement, parking displacement, adjust timings, concern about deliveries
Hillbrook	108	87%	road safety, air quality, adjust timings, concern about traffic displacement and parking displacement, also need crossing at Moring/Brudenell/Franciscan Rd, welcome other measures to support active travel too,	10%	traffic displacement, parking displacement, need larger area, potential confusion and penalties for people unfamiliar with the scheme, most traffic is generated by the school, access for people with disabilities
Penwortham	115	64%	should include Pretoria Rd, concern about traffic displacement, concern about parking displacement, larger area required, concern for those who need vehicle access, concern about deliveries, road safety, pollution	26%	difficulty for parents of children with special needs, should include Pretoria Rd, traffic displacement, parking displacement, timings too long, potential confusion and penalties - object to ANPR, inadequate consultation
