Dear Resident / Occupier

Implementation of the Southfields Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ), (S4) in Combemartin Road

I wrote to you in July 2021 to notify you of the Council's decision to extend the Southfields CPZ S4 sub-zone (operating 1.30pm to 2.30pm, Monday to Friday), into Combemartin Road.

This letter provides information relating to the implementation of the new zone and guidance on how to apply for a parking permit.

The new parking controls will come into operation on **Monday 6 December 2021**

- Parking bays will be marked where it is appropriate to park and yellow lines where it is not.
- Installation of posts, signs and lining will commence mid-November 2021.
- Between 1.30pm and 2.30pm, Monday to Friday, only vehicles displaying a valid S4 CPZ permit (resident, business or visitor) or paperless equivalent, will be entitled to park in bays to be marked on the highway roads with effect from Monday 6 December 2021.
- Disabled Blue Badge holders will be able to park free of charge and without time limit provided they display a valid blue badge.
- Warning Notices will be issued, instead of Penalty Charge Notices, to any vehicles not displaying a valid permit (or paperless equivalent) during the first week of operation of the new controls.

How to apply for a CPZ parking permit

Applications for resident or business parking permits and paperless visitor permits should be made online. Please visit the website below to register and apply:

You will need to scan and upload your proof of residence/business address and vehicle ownership before your permit can be issued. Please enter **Monday 13 December 2021** as the permit start date, so that you are not charged for the first week of operation. Failure to enter the correct start date could result in your permit being issued with an earlier start date.

Please note that each household may purchase a maximum of 100 resident visitor parking permits per year. Residents aged 70 and over and disabled residents may apply for 200 visitors' permits per year. These should be applied for via the same online account.

Due to the current safe working arrangements related to the Covid-19 pandemic, visits to the Council are on an appointment only basis from Monday to Friday, 10am to 4pm. Customers can book appointments by contacting the Parking Helpline on (020) 8871 8871 Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm. Alternatively, customers can use Webchat on the relevant pages of the Wandsworth Council website.

Each resident who has a valid CPZ resident permit is also entitled to 10 free One-hour Zone resident visitor permits a year, for use in zones across the borough that operate for one-hour each day and in which pay & display parking is not available during the controlled hour. This concession is provided for residents who occasionally travel outside their sub-zone, to another part of the Borough and need to park during the operation of a One-hour Zone.


These 10 free One-hour resident visitor permits are available on request by e-mailing parkingpermits@wandsworth.gov.uk or telephoning the Parking Helpline on (020) 8871 8871 Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm. They are not available from local libraries.
