PUBLIC NOTICE OF CONSULTATION

The Council hereby gives noticed that it has, today, made available three draft Supplementary Planning Documents (SPDs) for the purposes of consultation under the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012.

Subject Matter:

The Biodiversity SPD provides guidance on how biodiversity can be considered and incorporated at each stage of the development process. It includes detailed information about how proposals can ensure biodiversity is considered and enhanced in the Borough.

The Planning Obligations SPD provides detailed guidance on how planning obligations will be determined and applied in relation to different types of development in the Borough.

The Trees and Development SPD provides guidance for developers to assist them in managing and protecting trees during development. It aims to maximise the delivery and protection of trees during the planning process to improve the environment, biodiversity, health and built environment throughout the Borough.
