### Major Emergency Gas Works Garratt Lane, Earlsfield

Please note that there is currently multi-way signals on **Garratt Lane** for emergency gas mains replacement works between the junctions of **Earlsfield Road and Magdalen Road.** 

Magdalen Road Penwith Road and Summerley Street are all closed at the junction with Garratt Lane, Duntshill Road has been made one-way from Penwith Road to Garratt Lane to facilitate the works. Algarve Road has a banned Right turn from Garratt Lane
